50,000 won to all citizens to overcome COVID 19

Haeundae is providing emergency living support in the form of 50,000 won per resident to help those who are struggling as a result of COVID 19 prolongation and to revitalize the local economy. Korean residents who have an address in Haeundae can apply. Upon application, a prepaid card worth 50,000 won per person is provided. Prepaid cards can only be used in Haeundae, and cannot be used at entertainment establishments, gambling establishments or online shopping malls.

Arrivals from overseas at home and families at hotels

As of April 1, all passengers arriving from foreign countries must be self-contained for 2 weeks. Haeundae has entered into an agreement with hotels in the area and offers temporary accommodation at 10 hotels. Until COVID 19 ceases, families of individuals arriving from overseas living in Haeundae can use the hotels at a discount of 60-80% while the individuals are self-isolating. There are 10 participating hotels with 2,760 rooms available including Marianne Haeundae Hotel, Benikea Hotel, Hotel Foret Premier Haeundae, Ibis Budget Ambassador Busan Haeundae, Haeundae Centum Hotel, Citadines Haeundae Busan, Best Western Hotel, Shilla Stay Haeundae and Golden Tulip Haeundae Hotel & Suites.



Smile Haeundae: No Mask Worries

In order to overcome COVID 19, Haeundae signed an agreement with Eco-In-Blank, a social enterprise, on March 24, to produce more than 20,000 filter-replaceable cotton masks for children aged 3 to 8 years which were distributed in the Haeundae area. In the future, Haeundae-gu Office will also induce local residents to participate in the production of masks for senior citizens who collect recyclable paper and cleaners. A video will be produced and posted on the homepage so that residents can make their own masks.

Haeundae's social economic enterprises that practices sharing and consideration

Six social and economic enterprises operating in Haeundae donated 3,000 bottles of water to the district office to help the community overcome difficulties and also volunteered to deliver hand sanitizers and fire extinguishers to the traditional markets. 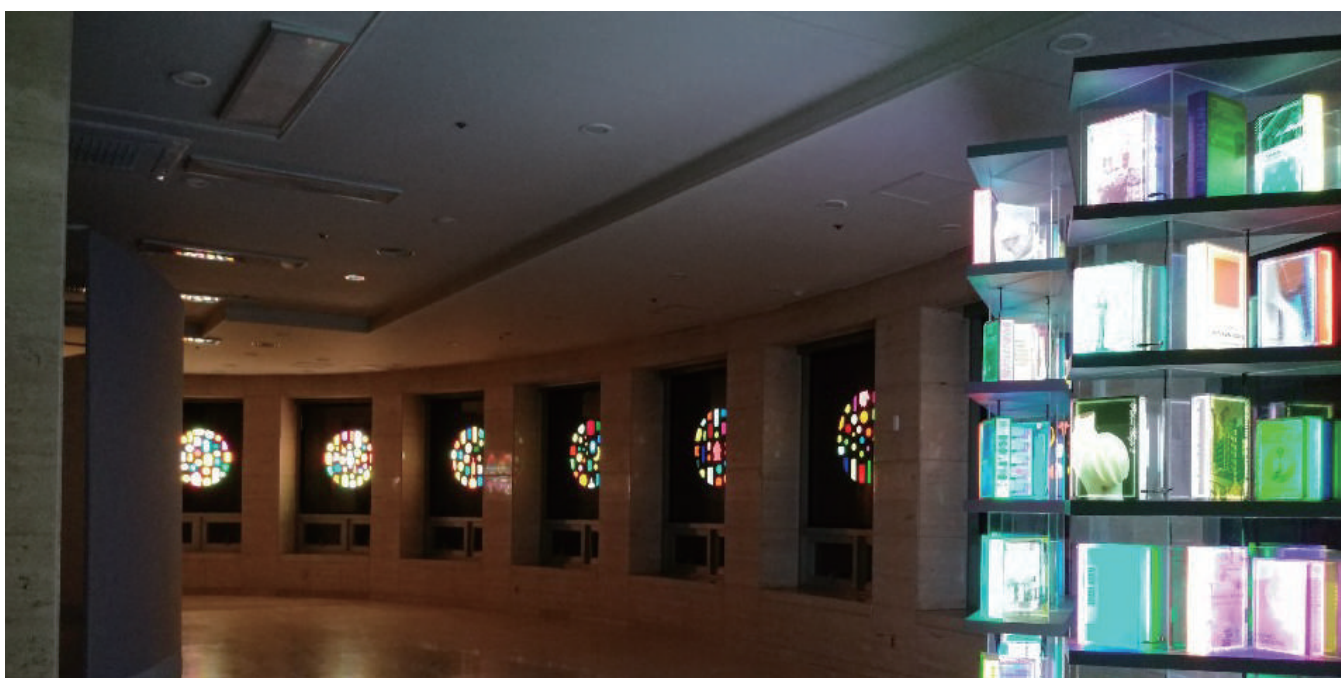
Iluda

Iluda is a company located in Banyeo-dong, Haeun-gu, which plans and hosts after-school sports programs and novelty sports events. It provides opportunities for sports activities to children who lack the opportunity to play together.



Chaconne

Chaconne on Haeri-dangil runs an academy-style cultural space. Street busking and indoor concerts are held, and their main focus is in the classical music business. This year, the company plans to diversify the Kids Classic program so that children can enjoy classical music easily.



Busan Museum of Art to hold children's participation exhibit

The Busan Museum of Art has prepared a Neverland-Lightland exhibition in the Children's Gallery. <Neverland-Lightland> is derived from the novel Peter Pan's Neverland and stimulates children's boundless imagination with the theme of light. Natural light coming in through the window and the curved exhibition space maximizes the image of Neverland. Various works such as paintings, sculptures, installations, and videos by seven domestic and foreign artists are exhibited.

Expanding the coverage of Haeundae's residents' safety insurance

Haeundae is expanding the scope of the resident safety insurance, which supports both Korean and registered foreign residents residing in the area. Gas injury death and aftereffects were added to the existing coverage items. Haeundae is the first city in Busan city to operate a resident safety insurance, which has been in operation since May last year.

Insurance coverage contents

Death by natural disaster death (including sun stroke and heat stroke): 10 million won
Death by explosion, fire, collapse, landslide accident death: 10 million won
Death by injury while using public transportation: 10 million won
Limit of up to 10 million won for aftereffects of injury while using public transportation
Death by burglary injury: 10 million won
Aftereffects of burglary injury: 10 million won
Death by drowning: 5 million won
Youth abduction, kidnapping, hostage: 100,000 won per day (up to 90 days)
Treatment costs for school zone traffic accident injury: 3 million won (injury grade 1-14)
Injury from righteous cause: 10 million won
Compensation for injury from sexual violence: 2 million won
Gas injury death: 10 million won
Aftereffects of gas injury: 10 million won
