## Clean Haeundae to Stamp Out Cigarette Butt Littering

Haeundae declared itself to be ‘Zero Cigarette Butt City’ last month. In an effort to make this the case, a movement will be organized encouraging citizens to vol-

untarily clean up cigarette butts littered on the streets and a campaign asking smokers to show intention to promise not to dump cigarette butts outside. Haeundae

will also designate Gunam-ro, Haeridan-gil, near Shinsegae Centum City Department and Jangsan station area as a test bed for the project and launch a clean

up campaign against dropping cigarette butts onto the streets once a month.

## Busan Cinema Center Library: All About Films

A library in the Busan Cinema Center, which is on the 4th floor of the building named Double Cone in the cinema center, is not only a film-specialized library with a large range of movie-related information but also a cultural complex where you can enjoy various activities re-

lated to movies. It has more than 39,000 archives of film data, and thanks to its designation as Busan branch of the Korea Film Archive, it also has space for visitors to enjoy 3,828 Korean classical and independent films. You can find particular information

on exhibitions hosted by Busan as a Cinematheque and movies throughout early to modern times, which can be seen only here. Furthermore, in books, theses, and other data you can see the development through history of the Korean film industry. For the convenience of visitors, cate-

gories of foreign and domestic films have been also organized separately. It is open from 9:30am to 8:00pm weekdays, 9:00am to 6:00pm weekends, and closed on Mondays, January 1st and during holidays including Korean New Year's Day and Thanksgiving Day.
