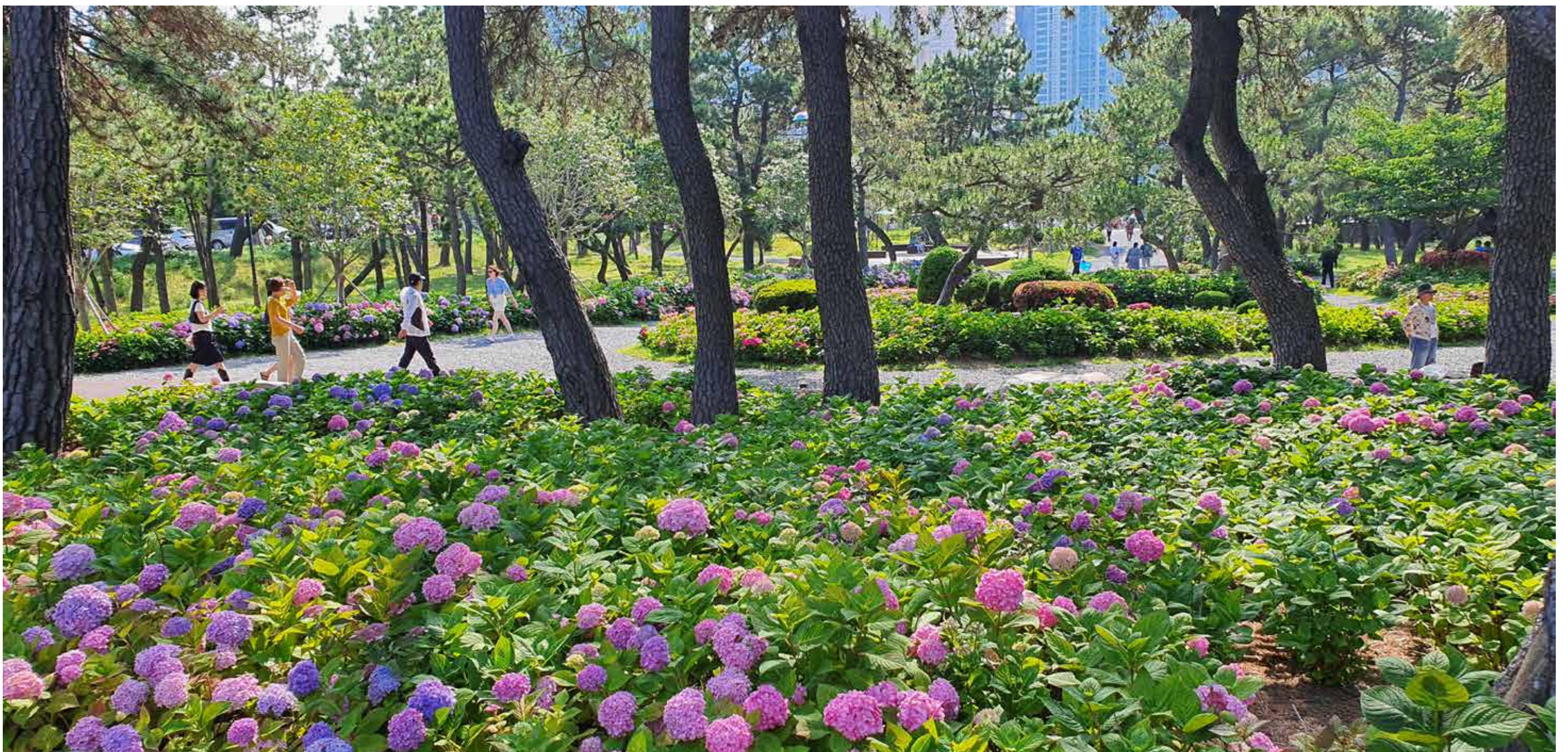

Haeundae, a City to Walk and Live in



Haeundae-gu has set out to make the city more pedestrian friendly in an effort to encourage residents to walk for their health. The city will complete the construction of a 150-meter red clay road by the end of this year in a bid to help residents improve their health using walking exercise. In addition, plans are in place to invest one billion won in creating a new

playground area for children and relaxation zones in the recreational green areas located in Banyeo-dong. On the red clay road, a variety of beautiful flowers will be planted including Korean azaleas and Korean lilacs to enrich the enjoyment of visitors walking the path, and safety facilities will be installed at the same time. Furthermore, Haeundae Park at the

edge of Haeundae Beach, will have 650-meter red clay road laid within a hydrangea garden next year.

Meanwhile, the mayor of Haeundae-gu is enthusiastic to promote walking culture to help improve residents' health as he himself walks every Thursday after work. The mayor is often spotted at various places, including near Hae-

undae Beach, Moontan Road and near Seokdaecheon, and uses the walks to converse with local residents in the area. As barefoot walking has gained popularity among people nationwide, the new red clay roads in the Haeundae area are expected to be popular with local citizens and helpful in improving people's health.

No Worries! Overseas Koreans who are Victims of the Jeonse Fraud Scandal to get Support

Victims of the nationwide jeonse fraud scandal from over the past few months who are overseas Koreans, facing their home to be auctioned off, are entitled to government support. The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, and Transport recently announced that if the

victims are overseas Koreans living in Korea, they are eligible to be offered emergency housing support equally as standard Korean citizens are. However, among foreign nationals, only Koreans with foreign citizenship who have finished registering their address, can be the

recipient for support. Under the support plan, the government will provide victims with public rental housing for up to two years and offer discounted rental rates. For more information, please contact the Korea Land and Housing Corporation in the applicable area.



Smooth progress for construction of new Haeundae-gu office



Having been approved at the second level by the government, the new Haeundae-gu office, currently in the working design stage, is finally ready to begin construction within this year. Located in front of the cultural complex center in Jaesong-dong, the new

Haeundae-gu office will be an eight story building with two underground levels and will have a total of 174.1 billion won invested in it. The construction order will be carried out this December with the goal of completion by December 2026. Haeundae was given

conditional first level approval regarding the construction of the new building from the government back in 2021. At the second level, various factors including an increase in the number of employees to be hired, expansion of convenience facilities for residents and

extended parking spaces were considered for approval. The current Haeundae office has been deteriorating since its establishment in 1981 and is in need of greater office areas, improved convenience facilities and better parking areas.
