HAEUNDAE BUCKET LIST 1 - TAKE A CRUISE INTO THE NIGHT SCENERY OF HAEUNDAE

You can see the famous Diamond Bridge (Gwanggan Bridge) in Busan at Gwangalli Beach or Haeundae at any time. However, the night view of the Diamond Bridge seen from the cruise ship with the lights reflected on the night sea is incomparably fantastic.

Tiffany 21 is a cruise ship which sets out from Dongbaek Island and passes through Haeundae, Gwanganri and Gwanggan Bridge. Unlike with yachts, you can enjoy the night view in a spacious area, and take in the lights of Gwanggan Bridge to the music of guitar performances as well as enjoy meals and events.

Tiffany 21 weighs 300 tons, and can carry 327 people. The first and second floors have live theaters and conference facilities. On the third floor you can enjoy views of the sea. It offers sightseeing to take in the coastal scenery of Busan for 2 hours while enjoying a meal on board. Contact 1577-7721 for inquiries.




MEETING WITH ART AT THE BUSAN CINEMA CENTER

If you go to the Busan Cinema Center, you can see sculpture works that create a unique atmosphere. The title of this work is "Woman- Bird-Transformation (Mirage)", and it is a stainless steel sculpture 10.2 meters in height and 4.6 meters in width.

The sculpture is a work by German sculptor Ralph Volcker Sander (1963-) and was set up in 2012 after it won an unanimous 1st prize in the international contest to select exhibit works for the cinema center.

Sander has been working on converting one image

into another and is inspired by his different cultural experiences and Buddhist-influenced ideas from his time spent living in in Korea, Japan, and China.

His work, "Woman-Bird-Transformation (Mirage)", shows a different image depending on the direction in it viewed from. From a distance, an elegant woman seems to be walking towards the viewer, and from the side it looks like a bird spreading its wings and looking forward. It embodies the seagull, a symbol of Busan, and female movie stars.

NEW PHOTO SPOT ON THE BEACH

Haeundae-gu has created a letter sign for visitors to create memories of their visit to the beach. Last year, we installed the letter sign 'HAEUNDAE' on Haeundae beach, and in January a 'SONGJEONG' photo spot was installed on Songjeong beach.



HAEUNDAE'S DALMAJI HILL IS CHANGING

Based on the cultural assets of the Dalmajigil area such as books, music and paintings, we will develop and nurture specialized businesses to create a special zone for cultural tourism. We aim to establish a specialized cultural and tourism area in 2022 by establishing a resident council consisting of residents, artists, and civic groups, and to carry out various projects to form a cultural community which will involve planning and participation by residents. In addition, we plan to hold special cultural events to brand Dalmaji Hill. We plan to produce and distribute a cultural map by gaining a precise grasp of the culture facilities around Dalmaji Hill, and to hold various events such as gallery tours, live busking, moonlight concert, humanities festivals and such.

In addition, it is anticipated that a new complex with flowers will be created in the Dalmaji area, creating new sights and tourism demand. The Haeundae-gu Office will plant 30,000 hydrangeas, silver leaves, lily turfs, and moss phlox in an area to cover the distance of 0.6km from Haewoljeong to Haesong Bridge, passing through the Dalmajigil Eoulmadang to create a pleasant park environment, which will also be a prime spot for photo taking.
