Full Efforts Put into Blocking Spread of New Coronavirus

Haeundae is putting in all its efforts to respond to preventing the spread of the new coronavirus infection. Both the 38th Haeundae Dalmaji & Hot Spring Festival and 2020 District Mayor Neighborhood Tour, which would have attracted a gathering of residents and were both scheduled for the 8th, were canceled. The hot spring footbath in the open garden of the district office has been temporarily closed as of 3rd February. We have also purchased hand sanitizers and placed them in places frequented by residents, such as the community service center. In addition, screening clinics have been installed at Haeundae's Public Health Center and Haeundae Paik Hospital to treat patients who are suspected of being infected.

Novel coronavirus infection Prevention dos and don'ts

Major symptoms

- Fever
- pneumonia
- respiratory symptoms
Cough, sore throat, etc.

Risk factors

- Appearance of symptoms
after visiting China

New Coronavirus Prevention Tips

- ✓ Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with your hands
- ✓ Wear a mask if you have respiratory symptoms such as coughing (mandatory when going out or visiting medical institutions)
- ✓ Wash palms and under nails thoroughly (for 30 seconds or more)
- ✓ Cough etiquette: Cover with a tissue, handkerchief or sleeve when coughing. In the case of covering with your hands, saliva may be transferred to handles
- ✓ Inform medical staff of any overseas travel
- ✓ Submit a health questionnaire upon returning from overseas travel
- ✓ Call the Center for Disease Control & Prevention Call Center (1339) or the Haeundae Health Center (746-4000) if you have a fever and respiratory symptoms (cough, sore throat, etc.) within 14 days of returning from overseas travel



Safety is the natural right of residents : Residents' Safety Insurance

Since May last year, Haeundae has been operating a 'Resident Safety Insurance' policy for all residents, including foreign residents, to cover damage from natural disaster, fire and such disasters, for the first time in Busan. So far, two cases have been filed and paid out, and three more cases are currently under review. During the registration period, residents will be automatically registered for the Haeundae Resident Safety Insurance regardless of age or illness, as long as their address is in the Haeundae region. Duplicate compensation is possible even if you are covered by another insurance policy or have an accident elsewhere in the country outside of the Haeundae area. In addition to deaths due to natural disasters, the insurance also covers 12 types of accidents and incidents such as fire, explosion, collapse and injury during the use of public transport, injury from robbery, drowning and traffic accidents in school zones, and compensation is up to the sum of 10 million won. In particular, compensation for up to 60 million won is paid to those who are injured while saving another person's life or property.

2020 New Parenting Support Policy

Early pregnancy tests

Blood tests and urine tests are provided free of charge at the Haeundae Health Center and the Banseong Health Center for pregnant women in the early stages of pregnancy (7-12 weeks).

Childbirth support payment

Busan Metropolitan City is providing monetary support for babies whose birth is registered in Busan, from the second child onwards. The amount is 500,000 won for a second child or 1.5 million won from the third child onwards. Haeundae pays 200,000 won once for the second born and 500,000 won from the third child onwards.

Support for nutritional supplements for pregnant women and loan of breast pumps

Folic acid is provided to pregnant women during the first two months of pregnancy and iron supplements for five months after 16 weeks of pregnancy. Breast pumps can be loaned for up to four weeks after childbirth.

Support for maternity goods

Busan Metropolitan City provides maternity supplies to all newborn babies and newlywed couples who have registered their marriage, and Haeundae is providing maternity encouragement supplies.

Support for medical costs for teenage pregnancy and childbirth

For mothers under the age of 19, the government will pay up to 1.2 million won per pregnancy for the cost of medical expenses related to pregnancy, childbirth, and infant care.

Atopy and Asthma Education Programs

Haeundae is providing education to children with atopy and any interested residents of Haeundae to teach them about related ailments and how to make natural moisturizers.

Children's vaccinations

Children under the age of 13 can get the 17 mandatory vaccinations free of charge at public health centers and private medical institutions

Free medical check-up for prospective parents

Free medical check-ups are given once a year to prospective parents who are preparing for pregnancy, and two months' supply of folic acid is given once a year to prospective mothers who have had the check-up.
