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The Beaches Open!... Haeundae and Songjeong Beaches Open for Swimming

Haeundae and Songjeong beaches officially opened on the 2nd of June. Lifeguard towers, buoys, and safety facilities excluding parasols will be installed for the month of June. Lifeguards will be working at the beach. Tourists can enter the water in the area from the tourist information center to the event square along 300 meters of Haeundae beach, and from the tourist info center to the complex rest area for 150 meters along Songjeong beach from 9am to 6pm. The entirety of these beaches will open from the 1st of July to the 31st of August.



Transformation of Daecheon Park in Haeundae Green City

Trails in the Daecheon Park and Deacheon Forest Culture Park in Haeundae Green City have been recently renovated. The old artificial cover of the road has been replaced with an eco-friendly product. Instead of old guardrails, reed-shaped guardrails well suited to the lake were newly installed. New wildflowers and trees were planted in the flower gardens in the Deacheon Forest Culture Park. Newly installed landscape lights surrounding the lake in the Daecheon Park enable the residents to enjoy strolling illuminated at night.



Haeundae Beach Radio

‘Beach Radio’ is a unique program of Haeundae beach and will be airing from July to October. The radio, which has been only on for three days from Friday to Sunday previously, will be airing in future for up to 4 or 5 days.

Beach Combing Festival to Clean up

The term ‘Beach Combing’ means an environmental activity to create recycled art by collecting trash and drift objects washed up by the sea. ‘Beach Combing Day’ with residents will be held from July to September. In September, a sculpture made of pieces of glass, empty bottles, and trash collected at the seaside will be displayed to demonstrate how seriously the ocean environment has become polluted.

Movies on the Beach

‘Beach Cinema,’ where people can watch movies sitting on the sandy beach, is planned to be open for the public to enjoy as a part of the Busan International Film Festival during September and October.

Songjeong Star and Sea Festival with Celestial Observation

‘Songjeong Star and Sea Festival’ is a unique event at Songjeong beach and will be held at the end of September. People can experience and enjoy celestial observations, astronomy classes, and science and music performances.

Busking of Various Performances

Busking at the seaside will be open to the public from the 7th of June. Visitors can enjoy a variety of performances, including singing and magic, etc., in nine spots in Haeundae and three places on Songjeong beaches respectively.

Wider Area for Surfing in Songjeong Beach

The surfing area on Songjeong beach will be extended by 240 meters from the current 120 meters. Songjeong beach, one of Korea’s three main surfing beaches, has allured many surfing lovers. Since the military will not visit Songjeong for summer vacation, surfers can enjoy the broader area of the beach and sea.

AI CCTV Detecting Those Entering the Water in Early Morning

A total of five AI CCTV cameras, three in Haeundae and two in Songjeong, will be installed to detect people entering the water early in the morning without permission.

A Ban on Entering the Water at Night when Beaches are Closed

To prevent any harm or casualties, entering the water at night is prohibited. When the beaches are closed, entering the water 30 minutes after sunset and 30 minutes before the sunrise is banned. Violators will be fined KRW50,000.

More Night Patrols to Prevent Safety Accidents

An increased number of night patrols will prevent safety accidents and crack down on illegal activities. Four groups for the night patrol with up to 20 staff will work between July and August to let people know about the prohibition on night swimming and put a stop to camping, fireworks, and commercial activities.

Portable Convenient Store in Songjeong

Songjeong beach is closing the open-air cafes but instead is opening portable, convenient stores in containers. Two portable stores will be open in front of the tourist information center and on the sandy beach next to the Jukdo park.

Surfing Board Room Opens in Songjeong

Opening a surfing board room on Songjeong beach will remove the risk of safety accidents for tourists and tidy boards away left on the sand.



Buses Embracing the Haeundae Run in the City

Four Busan city buses, two town buses, and two metro trains will be running in the city of Busan under the names of ‘Busan Marine Bus’ and ‘Metro Marine’ by September respectively. Images of Haeundae beach and Cheongsapo Mongdol (pebble) beach will be illustrated on the exterior of these vehicles. Vehicles with Jangnim port, Taejongdae park, Oryukdo islands, Busan Metropolitan Simin Library, and other new popular places of Busan will cater for tourists.
