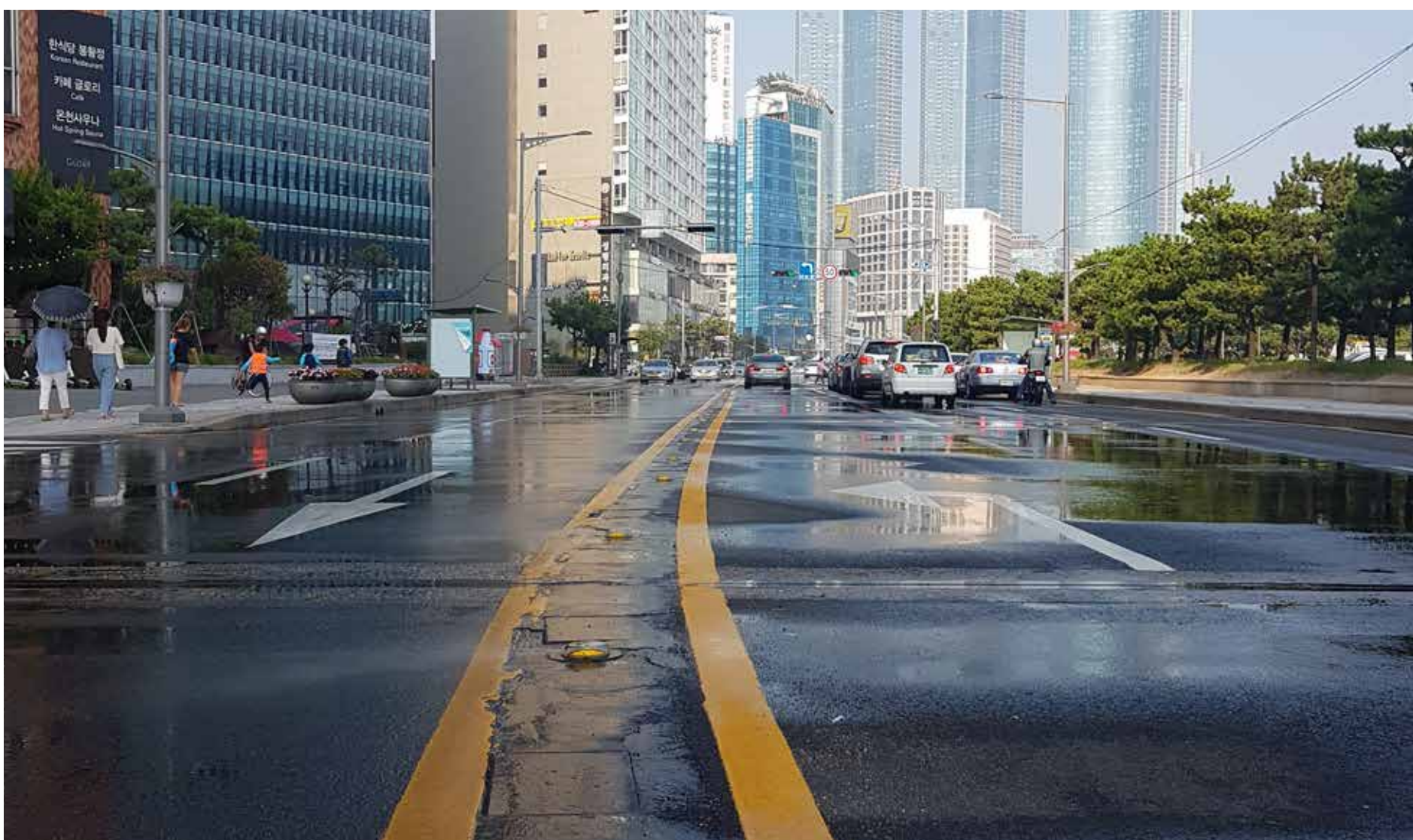

Effective Methods to Solving Traffic Congestion in Haeundae Identified

Busan city has included the Bansong tunnel and Haeundae tunnel construction projects in its road construction and management plan, accelerating the goal to reducing chronic traffic congestion in Haeundae. The city's construction plan is to prioritize the projects, with Bansong tunnel as the first project, and Haeundae tunnel as the fourth. The Bansong tunnel project is designed to expand the bypass to relieve chronic traffic congestion through the areas of Haeundae-ro, Suyeonggangbyeon-daero, Jang

san-ro, and Dongbusan Tourism Complex. A 9.2km stretch of the tunnel with a four-lane road will connect Geumsa IC, the 2nd Centum, and Dongbusan IC. A four-lane and 7.02km long Haeundae tunnel will connect Dongbaek crossroads in Udong to Seokday-ro in Seokday-dong. It is expected to ease the chronic traffic conditions between the whole area of Bansong and Udong.



Automatic Water Spray to Lower Temperature

Haeundae-gu has set up a remote-control system called 'Cooling and Clean Roads' to mitigate urban heat islands in the summer and reduce fine dust. The system automatically sprays water on the roads to reduce the temperature once a day in June and September, twice a day in July and August, three times in case of a heatwave alert, and additionally twice in the spring season in case of a fine dust forecast or warning. The water spray system has been installed 500 meters from the event square at Haeundae beach to the Guerinnarae hotel.



Jangsan District Park Opens At-a-Glance Website

The Jangsan District Park website opens on July 13. The site's main menu consists of Introduction of Jangsan District Park, Tour Guides, Jangsan Story, Information, and Make a Reservation. The tour provides information on scenic trails, including various starting points, their destinations, length, and difficulty levels, assisting visitors to enjoy comfortable and safe hiking. The recommended courses are categorized as Walking along the Mountain, Dulle-Gil (trail) Along the Ridge, and Scenic Trails with themes to offer customized tour information based on customers' needs. In particular, the main trails and recommended courses are well displayed on the map for hikers to easily find the trails of Jangsan, which are like a spider's web.



Enjoy Cool Summer Vacation in Haeundae Arboretum

Haeundae Arboretum will offer a new service for the convenience of visitors who visit in the hot summer weather. Busan city can lend parasols to visitors of the Arboretum and can also provide an Electric Cart tour service. The 14-passenger electric cart tour service is for those having difficulty walking, including seniors and those with disabilities, available from

9am to 5pm. The course is from the back gate of Haeundae Arboretum to the Circus. A program called 'Taking a round of the Arboretum with a forest tour guide in the electric cart,' in which the tour guide introduces the main garden of the Arboretum and tells passengers the stories of animals and plants enthusiastically. The program will continue until December.
