Haeundae Light Festival Comforts People with Hope

Haeundae-gu is hosting the 9th Haeundae Light Festival until the 24th of January 2023. With the theme of 'Again, Haeundae the Ocean of Light', the event area has been doubled and the number of programs in which citizens can take part are back to

pre-Covid-19 size. Light sculptures representing four different stories have been installed at Haeundae beach, Haeundae square in Gunam-ro, Haeundae market, and Haeundae Oncheon-gil to comfort people and deliver a message of hope. Haeundae beach

section where the main installation has been set up under the theme of 'Light Waves' has been extended from 200m last year to 400m this year to display more of the spectacular animated videos. On Christmas day, the 25th of December, a carol singing contest,

Christmas performance with UNICEF and a ceremony with 200 Santa Clauses will be organized. Only a maximum of 2,000 visitors will be allowed on the observatory deck at once and 35 staff will be mobilized to watch over visitors to ensure overall safety.



Transformation of Sports Park from Space Under Expressway

The construction of Songjeong Sports Park has been completed, which is located under the Busan-Ulsan Expressway. The area was used as a terminal for courier services and other multipurpose uses while being surrounded by a 3m-high screen fence. Haeundae has invested 410million won in

having sporting equipment and multipurpose courts among others installed. In addition, it has been designed for people with disabilities to have easy access to, and LED lights and bright colored flooring have been installed throughout the park for safety reasons.





Sub Level-Viaduct Green Space Created in Banyeo and Seokdae

Urban Wind Road Forest, a project designed to reduce fine dust has been created under the Banyeo and Seokdae viaduct. As asphalt road was eliminated, more flowers were

planted, and beautiful sculptures and landscape lights have been arranged instead making the space much greener. Near an intersection before Seonsuchon, a sculp-

ture depicting fireflies and deer co-existing has been installed. Various sculptures portraying a flock of sweetfish swimming up-Suyoung river and beautiful scenery of the

Seokdae stream and gardens in different shapes under the Seokdae viaduct have been appreciated and well-received by tourists and visitors.

Smooth construction of New Haeundae District Office
