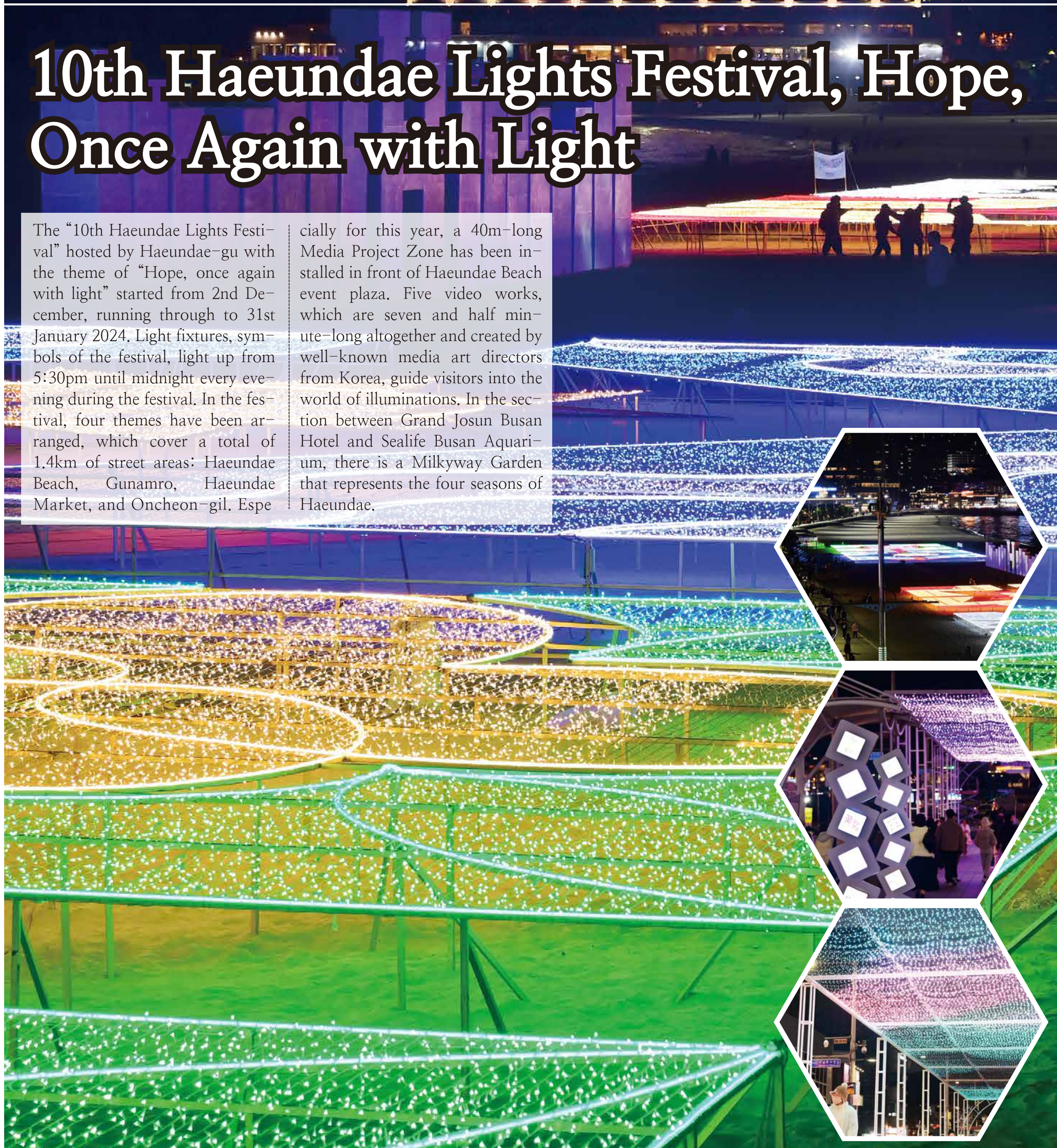

10th Haeundae Lights Festival, Hope, Once Again with Light

The “10th Haeundae Lights Festival” hosted by Haeundae-gu with the theme of “Hope, once again with light” started from 2nd December, running through to 31st January 2024. Light fixtures, symbols of the festival, light up from 5:30pm until midnight every evening during the festival. In the festival, four themes have been arranged, which cover a total of 1.4km of street areas: Haeundae Beach, Gunamro, Haeundae Market, and Oncheon-gil. Espe-

cially for this year, a 40m-long Media Project Zone has been installed in front of Haeundae Beach event plaza. Five video works, which are seven and half minute-long altogether and created by well-known media art directors from Korea, guide visitors into the world of illuminations. In the section between Grand Josun Busan Hotel and Sealife Busan Aquarium, there is a Milkyway Garden that represents the four seasons of Haeundae.



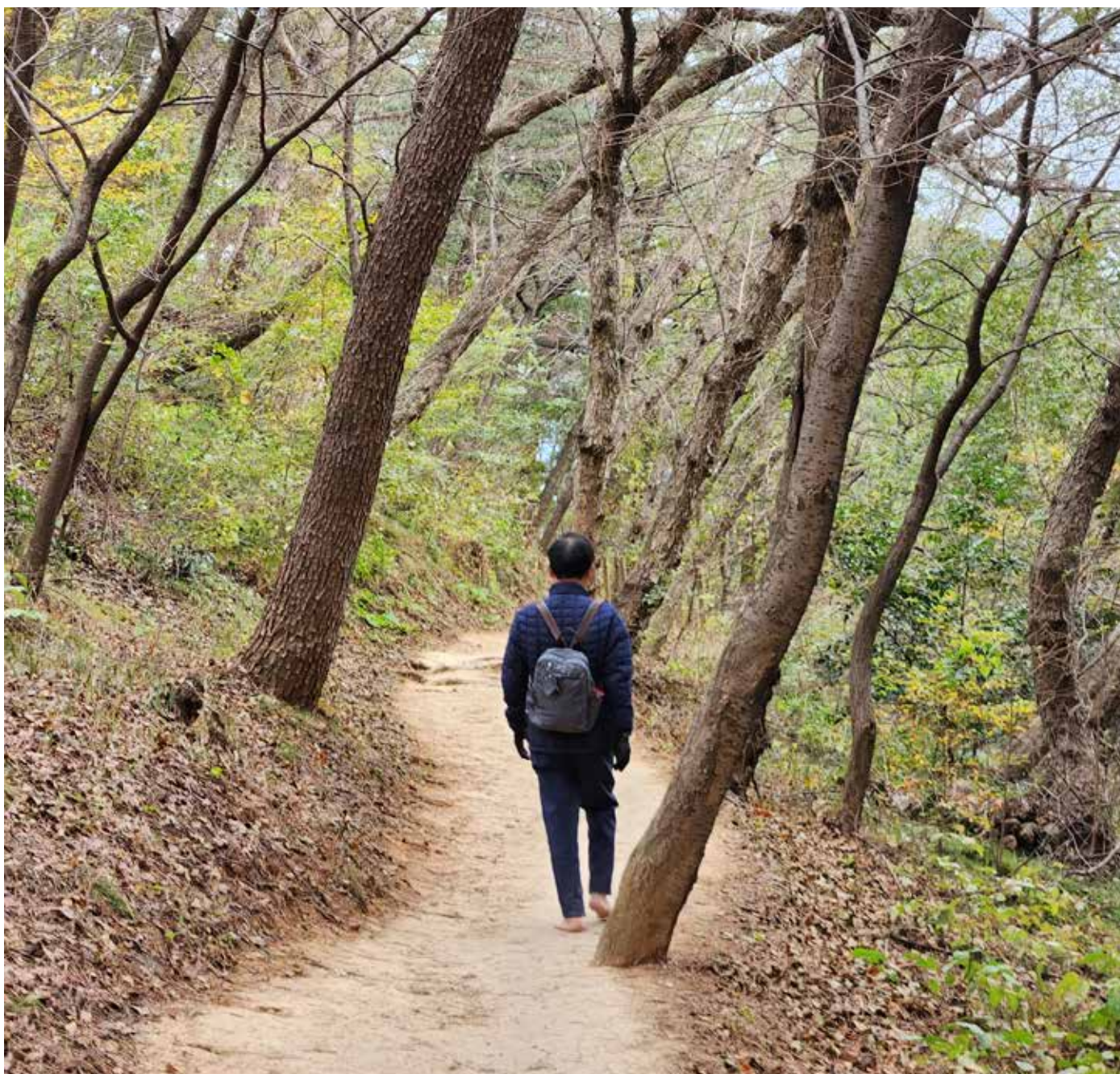
Songjung Marine Leisure Service Primed for Next Summer Season

The Rest Marine, a specialized marine leisure facility located in Jukdo Park, Songjung Beach, will start its business officially with its new operating company. The three-floor building has an education hall and a resting zone and plans to run water leisure activities for Jet Skiing, Banana Boats,

and Power Boats from next May. Even though the store was constructed in February 2013 by Haeundae-gu, it has not been operating owing to lack of funds, but now the new operating company has been selected to get it fully up and running.



Enjoy Barefoot Walking along Obongsan Mountain Olle Trails and Chorok Park



Obong Mountain is a low mountain at less than 200m above sea level in Banyeo-dong. There is also a well-prepared dirt road by the Small Library in the Forest,

where many people walk along barefoot. Walking up the forest trail linked to Chorok Park on the outskirts of Jangsan Mountain in Haeundae, you will arrive at the



site for Banyeo Hue recreational green space creation business. Here, on the 2,000m² site, is a 200-meter-long red clay road that can be walked on barefoot and a

50-meter-long roller slide will also be installed. Banyeo Hue green space creation project will be completed by late December.

Public Safety Experience Center in Haeundae-gu by 2028



A Public Safety Experience Center will be built in Haeundae-gu. Construction of the experience center will be a three-floor building and basement located in the area of Jaesong Station on the Donghae Line (877-3, Jaesong-dong) and is to be completed by 2028. There will be around 30 zones to experience different virtual disasters, and will include a library, a cafe, a seminar room, an indoor swimming pool and a

Metaverse Theater. Furthermore, special experience zones relating to marine leisure and radioactivity accidents, where regional characteristics are significant, will be equipped in the building.
